

Department of Psychology: Long Ad: Tenure Track (BPN 4198)

The Psychology Department at the University of South Alabama invites applications for a full-time (9 month), tenure-track Assistant Professor position to begin August 15, 2019. The position requires a Ph.D. in a basic research area of Psychology with area of specialization open (e.g., cognitive, developmental, physiological, social/personality, etc.). ABD candidates will be considered, but an earned Ph.D. is expected by the time of appointment.

Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate and graduate courses, maintaining an active research program, mentoring graduate students through the Behavior and Brain Sciences (BBS) M.S. degree program, and providing service to the Psychology Department, College, and University. The successful candidate will be a member of the BBS graduate program, which currently consists of seven faculty representing behavior-genetics, biological psychology, cognitive psychology, developmental psychology, physiological psychology, social-personality psychology, and teaching psychology. The BBS program is collegial and supportive and fosters creativity and collaboration among its faculty and students. We seek a colleague who will contribute to this positive communal environment.

The University of South Alabama (USA) is located in Mobile, Alabama, along the Gulf Coast. The area offers a wealth of outdoor activities and the campus is about an hour away from beaches and two hours away from New Orleans. USA enrolls approximately 15,000 students in more than 100 academic programs and includes an on-campus medical school. The Psychology Department is comprised of 15 full-time faculty and two graduate programs: the BBS program and an APA-accredited Ph.D. program in Clinical and Counseling Psychology. Significant opportunities for collaboration exist with faculty in both programs.
