OPEN TO ALL MAJORS AND MINORS, COURSES MAY SATISFY USA CORE AND LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

COURSES (classes daily, taught in English) up to 9 cr.hrs:

- **International Business** – How to do Business in Germany (3 credits/Course Equivalent TBA)
- **International Management** - (3 credits/Course Equivalent MGT 334)
- **German Language Courses (Introductory, Intermediate & Advanced levels available)**** - (3 credits/Course Equivalent based on level) Great opportunity to begin or enhance your German!
(**additional USA German language credit may be available/required of participants based on individual needs)

PROGRAM FEE INCLUDES: FH Worms fee: Euro 2,500.00*

- **Meals:** 22 meal vouchers and breakfast included. **(Meals while on tour NOT INCLUDED).**

 - In Berlin: 3-day visit/Tour of the Bundestag included
 - In Frankfurt: Visit to the Central Bank of Frankfurt
 - In Munich: 2 day visit /tour of two castles
 - In Heidelberg: Visit to the city and a castle*
 - In Mannheim: Visit to BASF enterprise

Transportation to Germany: Airfare NOT included. Each participant must arrange his/her own air transportation and transfer to Worms.

***OTHER FEES AND REGISTRATION:** (Cost based on Euro exchange rate as of 8/4/2008 approx. US\$3,903.00). Participants should budget additional funds for personal expenses such as additional meals, independent travel, laundry, souvenirs, etc. based on individual spending habits. USA students participating in this program or exchange must obtain 'transient' approval from their college and register at USA for IS 391 Study Abroad Germany for the term(s) they will be abroad in this exchange program. Fees related to the IS 391 registration include: Registration fee, emergency assistance insurance and International Education fee each term (approx \$260.00). All USA students participating in an approved study abroad experience (classes, internships, etc..) will be automatically enrolled in the USA 24/7 emergency assistance insurance program. When planning travel arrangements be reminded that program schedule includes arrival, check in and required orientations on May 15-16 with departure on June 13-14.

Dates, arrangements and pricing subject to modification based on availability, conditions and cost, check with OIE for updates.
